BLUE BUCKS PAPER PLATE PENNY PENGUIN

Hey, kids, here's a fun and easy project to make when you're stuck inside on those cold winter days. Here's what you'll need:

- a paper plate (the thin kind that will fold easily)
- black acrylic poster paint (or something similar)
- white glue or glue stick
- scissors
- stapler

First, take the paper plate and fold the left and right sides in, angling towards the top. See photo #1 as a guide. Then, fold down the top about 1 1/2 inches and staple. Next, paint the edges you folded inward with the black poster paint. Again, use photo #1 as a guide. Now, take the included insert and cut out all of Penny's assorted parts. Using photo #2 as a guide, glue all the parts to your paper plate. Once the glue has dried, Penny will be ready for some wintertime fun!
