## BLUE BUCKS EGG HOLDER

Hey, kids, here's a fun and easy way to display your Easter eggs this holiday with Milo in his snazzy new Easter suit! Here's what you'll need:

- Scissors
- Marker pen
- Tape or glue
- Easter egg coloring kit or a plastic Easter egg

First, if you're planning to color real eggs this year, have your parents pick up an Easter egg coloring kit. Be sure to follow the directions included with the kit. Milo's shirt doesn't need to be one color, so you can make it as fancy as you'd like or add a cool pattern to your egg. Remember, if you don't want to use a real egg, a plastic egg will work just as well. Next, take the included insert and carefully cut out Milo and both of his antlers. Don't forget to cut out the oval shape in Milo's belly, so the egg will show through. Once you've done that, wrap the holder around the egg snugly and mark where the two ends overlap. Now, glue or tape Milo's antlers to his head, then glue or tape the two ends together where you marked. Once everything is dry, if you used glue, carefully slip the egg into the holder. Milo is now looking good and ready to celebrate Easter with you!
